


Brecon Beacons

General Summary for Tuesday, 17 March, 2026



British Mountain Summary:

Based on forecast chart for noon 17 March, 2026

Widely windy, severe gales in Scotland. Rain in the western Scottish highlands edges into central highlands with time; early drizzle over many high slopes, lingering in Scotland, Lakeland, and Snowdonia. Sun breaking out afternoon over Wales and the Pennines with milder temperatures, though a chill in wind.

Headline for Brecon Beacons

Blustery, particularly early; early fog tending to clear, best east

Detailed Forecast for Tuesday, 17 March, 2026

How windy? (On the summits)	Southerly 25 to 35mph, strongest Cambrian range; more widely 35mph early in the day, and possibly up to 40mph west of Brecon to Preseli.
Effect of wind on you?	Walking strenuous in the morning, particularly in the west where balance may be challenged for a time. An easing trend with time, though staying very blustery in the west.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	Early light drizzle Early in the day, some light drizzle drifting over the higher summits, may linger until midday in the far west, but soon entirely dry.
Cloud on the hills?	Early blanket fog probably clearing most areas, lingering far west Cloud covering the hills widely from dawn, but may well mostly or completely break up later morning or middle of day, best breaks east and north. Preseli to western Brecon Beacons see the lowest early cloud, to lower slopes, breaks here too but banks often returning to high terrain.
Chance of cloud free summits?	Rising to 70% by afternoon
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Overcast and dull early, sun breaking out and becoming widespread eastern areas with very good visibility although a haze. More often cloudy west but sunny moments here too.
How Cold? (at 750m)	5C, rising to 6 or 7C, mildest east of Brecon. Temperature stays elevated into night and may even slightly rise. Feeling like -5C in direct wind.
Freezing Level	Above the summits
