

Brecon Beacons

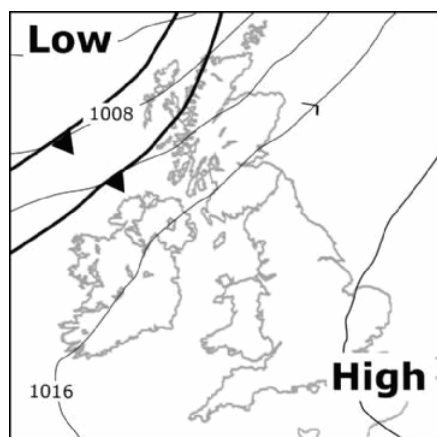
Includes all higher summits in the southern half of Wales: the Bannau Brycheiniog / Brecon Beacons National Park, southern Cambrian Mountains and highest Preseli hills.



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General Summary for Saturday, 8 August, 2026



British Mountain Summary:

Based on forecast chart for noon 8 August, 2026

Ranging from persistent gales, and increasingly toward west and north, rain and fog across the Scottish Highlands to blustery but largely dry Cumbria and S Scotland. Extensively warm and sunny elsewhere.

Headline for Brecon Beacons

Fine warm and sunny - beware sunburn.

Detailed Forecast for Saturday, 8 August, 2026

How windy? (On the summits)	Southerly 10-15mph, strongest west of about Llandoverly.
Effect of wind on you?	Small or negligible.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	Rain not expected
Cloud on the hills?	Not expected
Chance of cloud free summits?	Almost certain
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Extensive or unbroken bright sunshine. Excellent visibility.
How Cold? (at 750m)	11C rising to 16 to 20C, coldest west Wales.
Freezing Level	Above the summits.

How windy? (On the summits)	Westerly 15 to 20mph.	Northwesterly 10mph or less.
Effect of wind on you?	Small.	Negligible
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	Rain unlikely	Rain very unlikely
Cloud on the hills?	Little if any	All clearing during morning Cloud may come and go in morning on Cambrian range, but will probably clear the summits by midday.
Chance of cloud free summits?	80%	80%
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Periods of sunshine; excellent visibility.	Periods of sun - perhaps through areas of high level cloud and the Cambrian range may be intermittently cloudy. Excellent superb visibility.
How Cold? (at 750m)	13 to 15C, rising to 19C eastern hills.	10C, rising to 17C or a little lower slopes nearest Cardigan Bay.
Freezing Level	Above the summits.	Above the summits.

Planning Outlook**All mountain areas of Britain from Sunday, 9 August, 2026**

Extensively fine and warm early next week - indeed very little rain or low cloud and frequently light winds England and Wales all week.

Generally less settled after midweek northwestwards across Scotland where occasional rain and areas of low cloud.
