

# Brecon Beacons

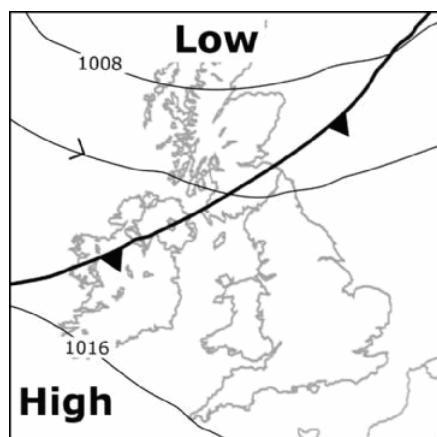

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### General Summary for Sunday, 9 August, 2026



#### British Mountain Summary:

#### Based on forecast chart for noon 9 August, 2026

A cold front, bringing rain and low cloud will progress only slowly southeast into central Britain. To the north, drizzly showers and low cloud will affect western mountains (mainly NW Highlands) whilst to the south mostly sunny and very warm.

**Planning Outlook****All mountain areas of Britain from Monday, 10 August, 2026**

Extensively fine and warm until Wednesday.

The almost completely dry and warm weather will then persist across England and Wales - although sometimes a little rain and low cloud toward Cumbria. Underfoot conditions will remain exceptionally dry.

Scotland, especially the W& NW Highlands, will have intermittent rain and low cloud - although probably still one or two fairly brief dry periods.
