

Brecon Beacons

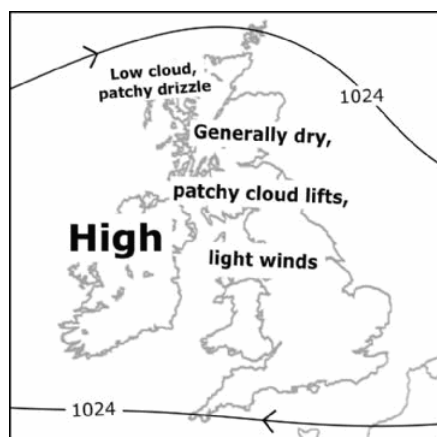
Includes all higher summits in the southern half of Wales: the Bannau Brycheiniog / Brecon Beacons National Park, southern Cambrian Mountains and highest Preseli hills.



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General Summary for Sunday, 23 August, 2026



British Mountain Summary:

Based on forecast chart for noon 23 August, 2026

A fine day for most places with light winds. Patchy cloud around some hill slopes early in the day will lift to leave many summits clear, but cloud banks are likely to persist on west coastal tops in Scotland, a little drizzle here in the morning, breezier too in the far northwest.

Headline for Brecon Beacons

Dry, hills clear most of day.

Detailed Forecast for Sunday, 23 August, 2026

How windy? (On the summits)	Variable often little wind, rarely 10mph, some upslope breezes forming.
Effect of wind on you?	Negligible.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	No rain expected
Cloud on the hills?	Little or none Some early mist on low slopes, brief fragments may drift upslope, but cloud generally forming above the summits.
Chance of cloud free summits?	Above 90%
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Sunshine best in the morning, scattered fair weather cloud building; sunniest near coasts later afternoon. Excellent visibility.
How Cold? (at 750m)	9C rising to 15C.
Freezing Level	Above the summits.

All mountain areas of Britain from Monday, 24 August, 2026

A fine start to the week with high pressure nearby, but easterly breezes will tend to strengthen. Most places dry through Monday and Tuesday, but generally deteriorating from the south into midweek as low pressure moves in from the south, patchy rain will increasingly spread northward with some local stronger wind. Broadly unsettled as next weekend approaches with bands of heavy rain forming mixed with showery bursts at times, but fairly warm and somewhat humid. Wind speed and direction likely to vary considerably day-to-day.
