

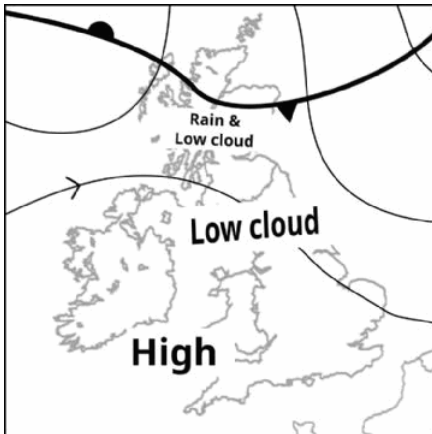
# Cairngorms NP and Monadhliath

## General Summary for Friday, 1 November, 2024



### British Mountain Summary:

#### Based on forecast chart for noon 1 November, 2024

Widely dull and overcast, in Highlands frequent rain, especially in the north, where windy at start. Mostly mild or warm. In England and Wales isolated spots of drizzle possible, but generally dry. Best chances for sun in northern Scotland in the afternoon, after the rain has passed.

Windy, murky and wet start, gradual improvement. Chilly

## Detailed Forecast for Friday, 1 November, 2024

<b>How windy? (On the Munros)</b>	Starting northwesterly, 25 to 35mph. Gradually easing to 10-15mph and becoming variable.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	<b>In the morning considerable buffeting, walking strongly impeded. Becoming small.</b>
<b>How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)</b>	<b>Rain fairly persistent north</b> Rain persistent for several hours, moderate to even locally heavy on northern Cairngorms. Lighter intensity and less frequent rain toward Braemar, but in general hardly any dry spot.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Extensive, chance for improvement</b> Cloud widely covering the hills, only lower slopes at times clearing if longer breaks in rain occur. Likely breaks in the afternoon.
<b>Chance of cloud free Munros?</b>	<b>40%</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Overcast and dull. Slowly improving in the afternoon with a little sunshine.  Poor visibility.
<b>How Cold? (at 900m)</b>	2 to 4C. With wind chill in the morning feeling near freezing.
<b>Freezing Level</b>	Above the summits.
