

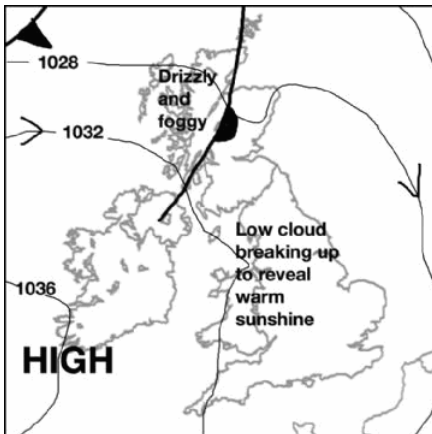
# Lake District

The entire Lake District National Park, taking in all major summits, including Scafell, Helvellyn, Skiddaw, the Langdales and Old Man of Coniston. Also includes the Howgill Fells east of Kendal (the NW extension of Yorks Dales).



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## General Summary for Thursday, 7 July, 2022



### British Mountain Summary:

#### Based on forecast chart for noon 7 July, 2022

Scotland: Low cloud extensive west/northwest Highlands with drizzle toward west coast; more widely developing western hills later. Cloud breaking up to sunshine in the east.

England and Wales: Low cloud and patchy drizzle mostly clearing to sunshine, but may linger some western hills.

### Headline for Lake District

Early low cloud and patchy drizzle clearing with sunshine breaking through.

## Detailed Forecast for Thursday, 7 July, 2022

<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>	Northwesterly typically 15mph, perhaps 20mph at times west Cumbria.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	Small
<b>How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)</b>	<b>Risk pockets drizzle western fells</b> All or nearly all areas dry. But risk western fells may have pockets of fine drizzle, most likely morning.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>All or nearly all clearing</b> Initially very varied: fog may well cover some areas from lower slopes upward, whilst other areas have breaks to higher slopes. From late morning, most areas cloud free, but on western fells (including Scafell area), banks of low cloud base 200-400m may well come and go.
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>20% lifting to 80%</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Sunshine will break through extensively and haze thin to give visibility excellent. However, probably dull and hazy at least intermittently western fells.
<b>How Cold? (at 750m)</b>	13C afternoon, although a few degrees colder where in cloud.
<b>Freezing Level</b>	Above the summits.

## Lake District - Looking Ahead

	<b>Friday 8 July</b>	<b>Saturday 9 July</b>
<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>	West to northwesterly 10 to 15mph, at times 20mph, and perhaps 25mph later.	Northwesterly 15 to 25mph, may ease further in afternoon.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	<b>Mostly small</b>	<b>Mostly small.</b>
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>Occasional drizzle.</b> Pockets of drizzle will come and go over the fells, most widely western most fells.	<b>Mostly dry</b> Isolated fine drizzle possible in low cloud, mostly morning.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Extensive, bases slowly lifting.</b>  Extensive low cloud covering the fells, lowest bases near coast. However, bases will slowly lift, and become more confined to higher slopes, local breaks in the east.	<b>Early low cloud mostly clearing.</b>  Murky start with areas of low cloud. Progressively low cloud will break up and lift in morning, so fells clear in the afternoon. Patches may linger in west.
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>30%</b>	<b>20% lifting to 60%</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Overcast in west, sun breaking through progressively further east. Widely murky and misty in west, good in east.	Cloudy start, patches sun progressively breaking through. Visibility becoming good or very good.
<b>How Cold? (at 750m)</b>	14C	11 to 14C, warmest in the east afternoon
<b>Freezing Level</b>	Above the summits	Above the summits

**Planning Outlook****All mountain areas of Britain from Friday, 8 July, 2022**

Persistent high pressure off SW Britain will bring extensive dry weather to and through next weekend, although in western Scotland, with the wind off the sea, often cloudy and fronts may bring rain on Sunday.

On western mountains the cloud will bring persistent fog until Friday, even to lowest slopes near the coast. However, remaining murky toward west coast of Scotland with further drizzle at times.
