

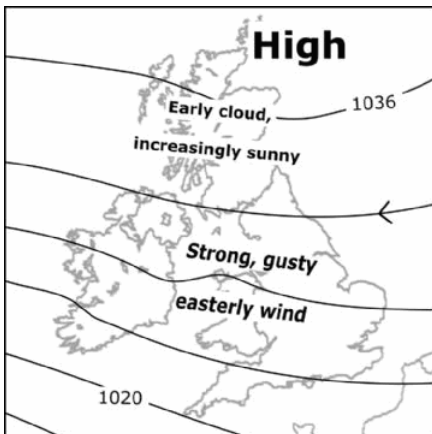

General Summary for Tuesday, 21 April, 2026



**British Mountain Summary:
Based on forecast chart for noon 21 April, 2026**

Brisk easterly winds for all areas will give considerable chill factor across the mountains; very gusty toward the west. A little patchy rain at first, otherwise a generally dry day. Cloud banks over the hills early in the day, particularly in the east, but increasingly breaking up to leave clear hills and sunshine.

Headline for Lake District

Windy, gusty, increasing. Patchy cloud, sunshine.

Detailed Forecast for Tuesday, 21 April, 2026

<p>How windy? (On the summits)</p> <p>Effect of wind on you?</p>	<p>Easterly 25 to 35mph, very gusty in places around higher tops, through passes and locally downslope to west, in places 40mph afternoon. Tending to strengthen, by evening into night generally 40mph, gusts 50mph.</p> <p>Considerable wind chill in exposure, blustery spots affect balance and make walking uncomfortable. Deteriorating further late in day onward to be more challenging on exposed terrain.</p>
<p>How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)</p>	<p>Precipitation rare if any</p> <p>From dawn into early morning, possible spots of light rain or a brief flurry of snow above 700m, mostly north/eastern areas. Otherwise dry all day.</p>
<p>Cloud on the hills?</p> <p>Chance of cloud free summits?</p>	<p>Lifting above tops, clearing</p> <p>Patchy cloud above 700m, mostly north and eastern fells in the morning. Tending to lift higher and increasingly all break up.</p> <p>80% rising above 90%</p>
<p>Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)</p>	<p>Variable cloud and sun, best further west, sun increasingly breaking through. Visibility very good.</p>
<p>How Cold? (at 750m)</p> <p>Freezing Level</p>	<p>1C rising to 4C afternoon. Directly in the wind, feeling like -7 to -10C.</p> <p>Near to freezing on highest summits in morning, then further above all tops.</p>
