

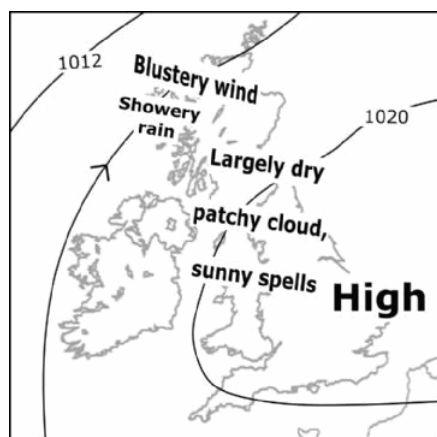
# Lake District

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## General Summary for Monday, 28 September, 2026



### British Mountain Summary:

#### Based on forecast chart for noon 28 September, 2026

Breezy over Scottish mountains, windier further northwest, feeling chilly. Showery for western Lochaber, Mull and around Skye, tending to fade during afternoon. Largely dry elsewhere, varied cloud over hills in morning, lifting and breaking above many tops with some sunshine. Lighter winds for England & Wales.

### Headline for Lake District

Moderate breeze eases. Patchy cloud clears hills, sunshine.

| <b>Sunshine?</b><br>Air clarity (below cloud)     | Fairly cloudy start near coasts, early sun best north Lakes, then becoming sunnier more widely into afternoon.<br>Visibility excellent.                                                                        |
