

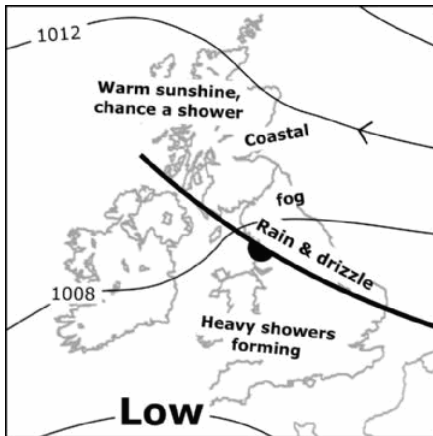
# Eryri / Snowdonia National Park

## General Summary for Thursday, 16 May, 2024



### British Mountain Summary:

#### Based on forecast chart for noon 16 May, 2024

Dry for much of the Highlands, but chance of localised afternoon showers in the west. Early areas of low cloud mainly central and east areas lifting. An increasing easterly breeze. Patchy rain northern England, heavier rain setting in for southern Pennines, later north Wales. Localised thundery downpours south Wales.

### Headline for Eryri / Snowdonia National Park

Local showers, rain developing, heavier later. Wind often light.

## Detailed Forecast for Thursday, 16 May, 2024

<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>	East or northeasterly, 10 to 20mph, varied during the day, then by evening likely increasing to 25mph.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	Fairly small, feeling breezy at times over higher exposed terrain.
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>Mostly dry start, rain moving in from east</b> A few hours in the morning largely dry, local drizzle or brief showers forming. During afternoon, rain becoming increasingly persistent from the east, continuing widely into the evening, some heavier periods of rain.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Varied over tops</b> Banks of low cloud mostly areas around Carneddau and possibly Berwyn range in the morning. Patches on higher tops in west, but breaking for periods. Forming and lowering to become extensive later as rain sets in.
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>70% dropping later to 20%</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Fairly cloudy, a little sun mostly in west before noon. Visibility mostly good, but reduced to poor in showers.
<b>How Cold? (at 900m)</b>	8 to 10C. Feeling like 3 to 5C in the breeze.
<b>Freezing Level</b>	Above the summits.

<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>	Northeasterly 10 to 20mph, strongest in the morning and toward north.	Northeasterly, 10 to 20mph.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	<b>Small.</b>	<b>Fairly small, but feeling cool in the breeze.</b>
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>Rain risk for most of the day.</b> Rain and drizzle frequent. Moderate risk of heavier bursts of rain, highest in mid Wales in the afternoon.	<b>Risk local showers</b> An odd patch of rain or brief shower in the morning, mainly toward east. Risk of isolated showery bursts forming during afternoon, mainly mid-Wales.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Extensive cover most of the day.</b>  Hills covered, low chance of clearing. Cloud base may start to lift a little afternoon into evening.	<b>Some low cloud or fog, mostly lifting</b>  Banks of low cloud mostly over east and northeast areas from Berwyn to Carneddau in the morning, lifting and breaking above most or all tops. Local patches if showers form. Some lower fog possible near to north coast.
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>10%</b>	<b>70%</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Mostly overcast and dull, chance of sunny spells towards Llyn Peninsula.	Variable cloud and sun, best toward Cardigan Bay. Visibility good, slight haze toward coasts, locally mistier for a time.
<b>How Cold? (at 900m)</b>	7 to 9C.	9 to 11C. Feeling like 3 to 5C in the breeze.
<b>Freezing Level</b>	Above the summits.	Above the summits.

**Planning Outlook****All mountain areas of Britain from Friday, 17 May, 2024**

Slack pressure patterns continue to drift around slowly. Plenty of dry and fairly warm weather, although feeling cooler toward the north and east this weekend and early next week. East or southeasterly breezes most common. Localised showers forming in the afternoons, chance of an isolated heavy or thundery burst. Low cloud affecting eastern hills at times, western mountains more often clear.
