

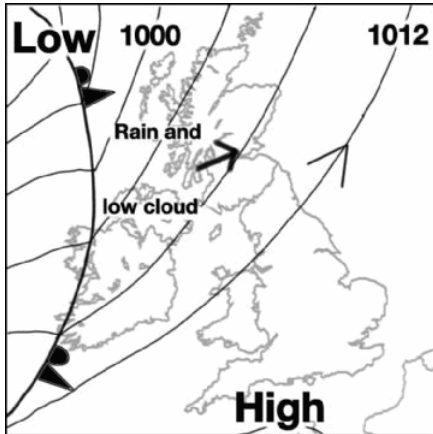
# Eryri / Snowdonia National Park

## General Summary for Friday, 2 August, 2024



### British Mountain Summary:

#### Based on forecast chart for noon 2 August, 2024

Rain and will advance gradually across Scotland from the middle of the day onwards, and in evening reach mountains close to the Irish Sea. There will also be areas of low cloud. Nevertheless, for many areas, including east Scotland extensively dry and warm. Upland wind approaching gale force western Scotland.

#### Headline for Eryri / Snowdonia National Park

Windy west Wales. Chance of a little rain late on. Low cloud near Lleyn peninsula.

## Detailed Forecast for Friday, 2 August, 2024

<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>	South to southwesterly, strongest west Wales where 25 to locally 40mph later afternoon. Otherwise: 15 to later 20mph.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	<b>In NW Wales, considerable buffeting at times in sudden gusts, sometimes on lower slopes.</b>
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>Rain unlikely</b> The odd burst of rain almost anywhere later in day, although fine drizzle in places where in cloud. Toward dusk more frequent rain will reach northwest Wales.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>  <b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>Summits often cloud free, but fog some western areas</b> Westernmost hills Lleyn peninsula to western flanks of Snowdon: Extensive or persistent fog, from coastal cliffs or lower slopes up Lleyn peninsula to a varied 400 to 750m elsewhere. Remaining area: Cloud will come and go on higher tops, but hills mostly cloud free. <b>50% but 20% near Snowdon</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Mostly dull and often misty Lleyn peninsula to western flanks of Snowdon. Patches of sun and good visibility (although a haze) elsewhere.
<b>How Cold? (at 900m)</b>	11C westernmost hills to in afternoon 17C east Wales and Carneddau.
<b>Freezing Level</b>	Above the summits

	<b>Saturday 3 August</b>	<b>Sunday 4 August</b>
<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>  <b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	Westerly, 15mph.  <b>Small.</b>	South-southwesterly, increasing from 15mph to 30-35mph, gusts 45mph in exposed locations.  <b>Small at start, deteriorating, becoming blustery, walking arduous and balance highly affected.</b>
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>Rain unlikely</b> An odd spot of brief drizzle not fully ruled out.	<b>Rain unlikely</b>
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>  <b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>Hills mostly clear</b>  Clouds briefly shrouding higher tops, but very likely confined above all summits by late morning.  <b>80%</b>	<b>Hills clear most of the day</b>  In the morning low level cloud possibly covering some mid- and lower slopes, later rising above the hills widely. Perhaps some more clouds around Llyn Peninsula.  <b>70%</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Cloud breaking up to give extensive bright sunshine Visibility very good although some haze.	Sunny spells in the morning, deteriorating from the west, in the afternoon sunshine only eastern slopes. Increasingly hazy near west coast, excellent visibility elsewhere,
<b>How Cold? (at 900m)</b>  <b>Freezing Level</b>	8 to 12C  Above the summits	10 or 14C  Above the summits

**Planning Outlook**

**All mountain areas of Britain from Saturday, 3 August, 2024**

Low pressure centres, mostly passing northwest of Scotland), and their associated fronts, will intermittently windy and wet conditions next week. Most rainfall will be on western mountains, with considerable rainfall on the W & NW highlands of Scotland. Frequently windy across Scotland. Lowest rainfall will be in eastern Scotland, the southern Pennines and easternmost Wales. Temperature wise warm and very humid on Monday, but through the week generally colder than this week.
