

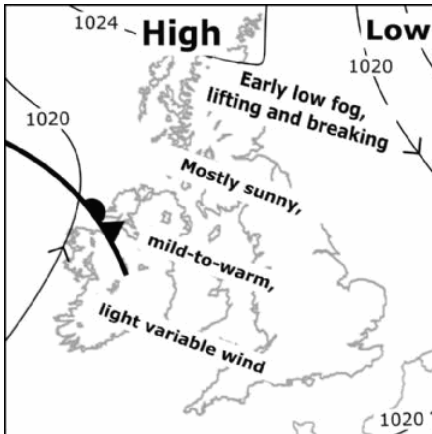

General Summary for Saturday, 25 April, 2026



British Mountain Summary: Based on forecast chart for noon 25 April, 2026

Low fog in north and east Scotland in the morning, lifting and breaking, may linger in eastern areas; chilly here too for several hours. Often sunny England and Wales with warm temperatures; some high cloud around, but beware sunburn risk. Later cooling in southeast Scotland and N Pennines. Negligible wind.

Headline for Eryri / Snowdonia National Park

Warm sunshine, some high cloud; cool valleys early

Detailed Forecast for Saturday, 25 April, 2026

How windy? (On the summits)	Variable less than 10mph.
Effect of wind on you?	Negligible.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	No rain expected
Cloud on the hills?	None expected
Chance of cloud free summits?	Practically certain
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Extensive sunshine, some high cloud around, occasionally thickening and weakening the sun. Visibility excellent, slight low-level haze early.
How Cold? (at 900m)	9 or 10C, may rise a degree.
Freezing Level	Above the summits. Patchy frost at dawn sheltered valleys of east Wales.

Trending variable in direction and towards lower speeds.</p> <p>Mostly small, through a notable breeze in the morning, some gustiness too.</p>	<p>Northerly 10-15mph; may shift northeasterly afternoon, notable gusts to 20mph.</p> <p>Fairly small, though some inconvenient gusts over high terrain at times.</p>
<p>How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)</p>	<p>Risk scattered showers, likely dry</p> <p>Local showers here and there, the showers generally light and fleeting; a small risk of a heavier burst east Wales, but most hills stay dry.</p>	<p>Chance scattered showers</p> <p>Scattered showers here and there, greatest risk on northern slopes. Risk of heavier showers east Wales.</p>
<p>Cloud on the hills?</p> <p>Chance of cloud free summits?</p>	<p>Likely cloud-free</p> <p>Patchy mist in east-Wales valleys, this soon dissipating after sunrise for cloud-free hills. Snowdonia may be cloud-free dawn to dusk.</p> <p>90%</p>	<p>Banks lingering on high northern slopes</p> <p>Banks of cloud at various elevations from dawn, lifting to mostly 800-900m and up through morning and becoming well-broken towards mid-Wales. Northern slopes and high tops of Snowdonia more often capped.</p> <p>60%</p>
<p>Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)</p>	<p>Often sunny, though weakened by high cloud, which may thicken. Very good visibility.</p>	<p>Often sunny mid-Wales, more often cloudy north Snowdonia, then a patchwork of sun afternoon. Very good visibility, though an early haze.</p>
<p>How Cold? (at 900m)</p> <p>Freezing Level</p>	<p>9 or 10C. (Starting several degrees cooler in the valleys, rising to 18 or 19C.)</p> <p>Above the summits.</p>	<p>7 or 8C.</p> <p>Above the summits.</p>

Planning Outlook

All mountain areas of Britain from Sunday, 26 April, 2026

High pressure remains dominant this weekend and into next week: regularly sunny and pleasantly warm days; summit temperatures often at or above 10C, many valleys will warm up toward 20C afternoon. Risk of sunburn in strong sunshine and very dry springtime ground conditions with high risk of wildfire. Risk of showers Sunday and Monday, which could be heavy Monday, some risk of thunderstorms developing in England, though confidence is low. The middle of next week remains settled with sunshine, patchy dawn mist that soon fades. An easterly wind establishes in Wales from mid-week, then a rising risk of wind pushing northward with rain following. Long-term detail is very uncertain, but a trend towards cooler, more unsettled weather is indicated in early May.
