

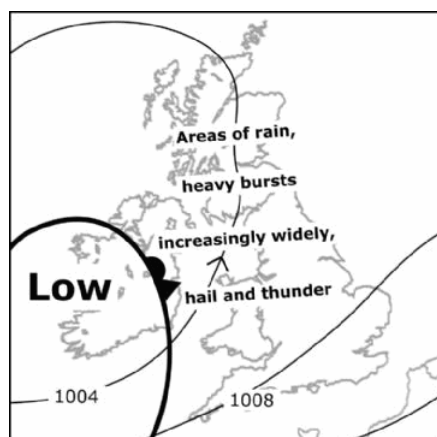
Eryri / Snowdonia National Park

General Summary for Sunday, 30 August, 2026



British Mountain Summary:

Based on forecast chart for noon 30 August, 2026

Areas of rain and low cloud around many mountains. Some drier periods in the morning, but into afternoon increasingly widespread heavy downpours and thunderstorms develop. Fairly light winds for much of the Highlands, becoming breezier England, stronger winds on Welsh mountains.

Headline for Eryri / Snowdonia National Park

Rain and increasingly thundery bursts. Wind strengthening.

Detailed Forecast for Sunday, 30 August, 2026

How windy? (On the summits)	South-southwesterly 20-25mph in morning, strengthening, to often 35mph afternoon with some stronger gusts around showers.
Effect of wind on you?	Increasingly blustery, ease of walking becomes affected, then more strenuous conditions, gusts knocking you off balance on exposed high areas; marked wind chill.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	Rain most of day, heavy downpours; risk of lightning Rain and drizzle in the morning, fairly persistent on western hills, some heavier falls; drier for a time in east. Developing increasingly by late morning onward into widely frequent heavy bursts of rain, risk of hail and thunder.
Cloud on the hills?	Fairly extensive, brief improvement Fairly extensive from dawn, many hills shrouded to middle slopes, particularly west. A lifting trend for a time, some high breaks forming to north & east. Cloud will fill back in across high terrain and increasingly lower as rain sets in.
Chance of cloud free summits?	20%
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Largely cloudy, rare brief sun. Visibility varying, poor in rain, locally good if dry, mainly east in morning.
How Cold? (at 900m)	10C rising to 12C, cooling again before evening. Feeling like 0 to 3C in strongest wind.
Freezing Level	Above the summits.
