

Southeastern Highlands

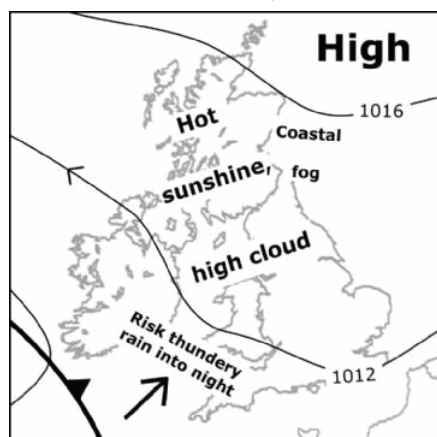
The southern Highlands as far west as the Callander area and north to Loch Erich, Drumochter and summits near Glenshee ski-centre (summits within the historic county of Perthshire). Also Ochils and Angus hills.



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General Summary for Sunday, 13 July, 2025



British Mountain Summary:

Based on forecast chart for noon 13 July, 2025

Very warm across the mountains from overnight, soon feeling hot in morning sun. Some valleys again approaching 30C by early afternoon, though mostly slightly less hot than Saturday. A veil of high cloud tending to weaken the sun. Local gusty E-SE'ly winds. Generally dry, later a chance of very isolated showers.

Headline for Southeastern Highlands

Very warm, sun and increasing high cloud.

Detailed Forecast for Sunday, 13 July, 2025

How windy? (On the Munros)	South to southeasterly 10-15mph, strengthening a little during day, to 20mph at times particularly eastern areas.
Effect of wind on you?	Mostly small, but feeling breezier with time on higher areas.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	Rain very unlikely Chance of localised spots of rain from high cloud later in day remote risk of an isolated thundery shower central areas.
Cloud on the hills?	Hills clear Local patches of haar from North Sea on lowest eastern slopes around dawn will soon clear. Fog/low cloud may return to southeasternmost hills as night falls.
Chance of cloud free Munros?	100%
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Sunny most of the day, some high cloud increasingly weakening the sun. Excellent visibility.
How Cold? (at 900m)	15 to 16C, already very warm from overnight, rising towards 18C central highlands; dropping slightly into evening. Central valleys reaching 27C by early afternoon, locally approaching 30C.
Freezing Level	Above the summits

All mountain areas of Britain from Monday, 14 July, 2025

Low pressure is likely to be common in the extended outlook with slow-moving areas of showery rain, some thundery bursts locally, interspersed with drier days. Temperatures often on the warm side, some humid days.

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
