

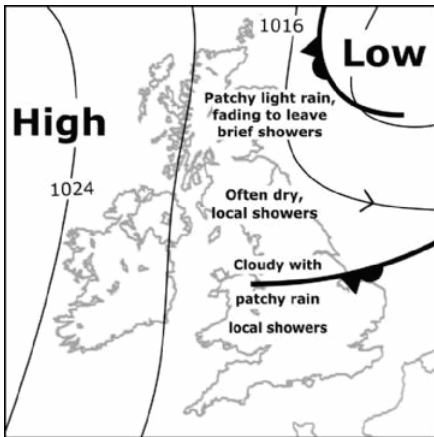
# West Highlands

Western Highlands accessible from, and south of, Glenfinnan (Road to the Isles) and Glen Spean (includes Creag Meagaidh). This area includes Ben Nevis and the mountains around Glencoe. In the east, from Ben Alder south to Loch Lomond and Trossachs NP. Also Arran and Mull.



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## General Summary for Thursday, 11 July, 2024



### British Mountain Summary:

**Based on forecast chart for noon 11 July, 2024**

Extensive cloud, more frequent rain in the morning on Snowdon range and in the Cairngorms. Sunny spells likeliest on the western Scottish coast. where cloud may lift during the day above most hills, leaving highest Munros in clouds. Windy on the eastern Highlands. Mostly cool temperatures.

Mostly dry, sunny spells especially on the coast

## Detailed Forecast for Thursday, 11 July, 2024

<b>How windy? (On the Munros)</b>	Northerly 15 to 20mph.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	Fairly small.
<b>How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)</b>	<b>Little or no rain</b> A few brief showers in the morning possible, most likely dry afternoon.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Hills mostly clearing during the day</b> Toward Loch Lomond NP often hills cloud-free, on the coast often banks of clouds at start with bases around 600m, soon lifting above most hills, highest Munros may not clear.
<b>Chance of cloud free Munros?</b>	<b>70%</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Patchy sun only. Visibility excellent.
<b>How Cold? (at 900m)</b>	6 to 9C
<b>Freezing Level</b>	Above the summits

<b>How windy? (On the Munros)</b>	Northerly, 10-15mph or less.	North to northeasterly, mostly 15 to 20mph.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	<b>Small.</b>	<b>Fairly small.</b>
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>Mostly dry</b> An odd shower possible toward Lochaber, but largely dry.	<b>Mostly dry, localised drizzly showers</b> Brief, drizzly showers, most likely dry toward Lochaber.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Hills mostly clear</b>  Except for morning mist hills largely clear. Some patches may lower across higher slopes in Ben Nevis range later in day.	<b>Hills mostly clear</b>  Mostly clear, patches of clouds coming and going on highest Munros
<b>Chance of cloud free Munros?</b>	<b>80%</b>	<b>70%</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Sunniest early morning, mostly fair weather clouds developing from north afternoon.  Very good visibility.	Sunny spells particularly on the coast, but may be frequent also inland.  Good visibility.
<b>How Cold? (at 900m)</b>	8C rising to 10C, locally 12C inland by afternoon. On highest summits in the breeze, feeling near-freezing at times.	11C
<b>Freezing Level</b>	Above the summits	Above the summits

**Planning Outlook****All mountain areas of Britain from Friday, 12 July, 2024**

Extensively dry over the next few days, although with one or two 'shallow' areas of low pressure close to Britain, rain is likely for a few hours in some areas - or sometimes afternoon heavy showers. Generally winds light; some sunshine, but overall fairly extensive cloud. A little less cold.
