

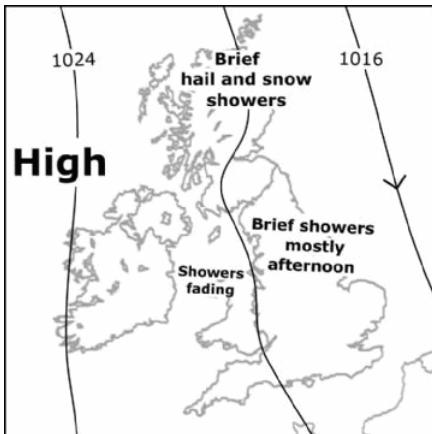
# Yorkshire Dales & North Pennines

The entire Yorkshire Dales National Park and North Pennines AONB, including the Three Peaks and Cross Fell, plus Howgills, also south to Forest of Bowland.



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## General Summary for Tuesday, 11 June, 2024



### British Mountain Summary:

#### Based on forecast chart for noon 11 June, 2024

Staying chilly across the mountains, but a gradual lift of temperature above freezing toward highest tops. Northerly winds fairly light but still a distinct chill in the air. A scattering of brief showers with hail, but a lot of dry weather with very clear air and cloud clearing most tops.

### Headline for Yorkshire Dales & North Pennines

Chilly breeze. Scattered brief showers forming.

## Detailed Forecast for Tuesday, 11 June, 2024

<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>	Northwest or northerly 15mph.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	<b>Small; although in the low temperatures will feel particularly cold in the wind.</b>
<b>How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)</b>	<b>Hail showers, mainly afternoon</b> One or two brief hail showers afternoon - although possibly heavier showers easternmost areas.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Very little if any</b>
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>90%</b>
<b>Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)</b>	Bright sunshine morning before cloud more or less fills in. Excellent or superb visibility.
<b>How Cold? (at 700m)</b>	3C post dawn; rising to around 7C by mid-afternoon. Wind chill feeling like -3C early morning, still near freezing in afternoon.
<b>And in the valleys</b>	Risk slight frost some upland valleys at dawn; will reach around 14C in the afternoon.

	<b>Wednesday 12 June</b>	<b>Thursday 13 June</b>
<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>  <b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	West or northwesterly, 10 to 15mph or less.  <b>Small</b>	Southerly, 20 to 35mph, strengthening during the day, risk later over 40mph higher terrain.  <b>Increasingly blustery over the fells, likely deteriorating further to make walking arduous over exposed terrain.</b>
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>Little or no precipitation</b> Chance of isolated brief showers, of hail higher slopes, mainly toward east in afternoon.	<b>Rain moving in</b> Dry start, possibly into the afternoon, but an increasing risk of rain arriving from the southwest, becoming persistent, later heavier especially south from Tebay.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>     <b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>Very little if any</b>     <b>90%</b>	<b>Varied, good breaks; lowering in rain</b>  Patches of cloud locally in the morning, but most fells clear for several hours at least. Cloud base lowering across the fells as rain develops, forming to midslopes in western Yorks Dales later.  <b>70% dropping to 20% in rain</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Cloud gradually filling in. Superb visibility.	Glimpses of weak sun giving way to overcast skies from west. Good visibility reducing to be poor in rain.
<b>How Cold? (at 700m)</b>  <b>And in the valleys</b>	4C rising to 8C.  Ground frost some valleys at dawn. By early afternoon, typically 14 or 15C.	5 to 8C. Feeling sub-zero in the wind, near -5C as speeds increase. 5C or locally colder at dawn. Rising to 14C.

**Planning Outlook**

**All mountain areas of Britain from Wednesday, 12 June, 2024**

Cold conditions will ease through midweek and winds will drop lighter. Low pressure approaching from the southwest by Thursday will see winds switch south to southeasterly and strengthen to gale force over west coastal mountains. Rain will move in from the west, becoming heavy. An unsettled outlook into the weekend and early next week as low pressure circulates slowly over the British Isles, bringing areas of rain and thundery showers. Wind speed and direction will vary, at times strong easterlies northern Scotland, west to southwesterly for Wales and Pennines. Temperatures will be higher, above freezing to tops, but not especially warm.
