

# British Mountain Summary: Based on forecast chart for noon 28 July, 2024

Fine almost everywhere, although low cloud will take most the morning to clear summits in some areas. Periods of sun, although cloud will bubble up at times. Blustery coastal hills NW Highlands; otherwise fairly light wind, especially Pennines and east Wales.

Dry; periods of sun. Very warm. Light wind.

# Detailed Forecast for Sunday, 28 July, 2024

How windy? (On the summits)	Southerly, 10mph or less.
Effect of wind on you?	Negligible.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	Rain very unlikely
Cloud on the hills?	Not expected
Chance of cloud free summits?	Almsot certain
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Extensive sunshine, although patchy cloud afternoon. Excellent or perhaps by afternoon, superb visibility.
How Cold? (at 700m)	10C, rising to a warm 17C mid afternoon.
And in the valleys	Reaching 22 to perhaps locally 24C mid to late afternoon.

How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	Rain very unlikely	Rain not expected  Small risk fine drizzle here and there western dales in Yorkshire until mid or late morning.
Cloud on the hills?	Very little if any	Summits all clearing  Some uncertainty as to whether low cloud reaches western dales in Yorkshire as a weakening front approaches overnight. Should it have formed, the low cloud very likely break up again by about midday.
Chance of cloud free summits?	90%	80%
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Sunshine, although often weak (due to high level cloud). Excellent visibility.	Periods of sunshine, although cloudy for periods.  Mostly excellent, perhaps superb, visibility.
How Cold? (at 700m)	11C rising to a warm 18C.	12C, rising toward a warm 20C, warmest north lakes.
And in the valleys	24 or 25C in the afternoon.	Rising to a very warm 24 to perhaps in places 26C in afternoon.

# **Planning Outlook**

## All mountain areas of Britain from Monday, 29 July, 2024

Extensively fine, very warm and light wind until mid week, although cloudy with a little rain NW Scotland on Monday. Remaining warm with mostly light wind later in the week, but bursts of sometimes thundery rain increasingly likely - at this stage uncertain as to the areas most affected.
