

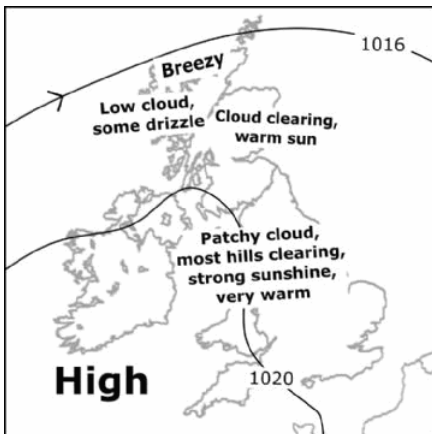

## General Summary for Wednesday, 8 July, 2026



### British Mountain Summary: Based on forecast chart for noon 8 July, 2026

Damp with blanket low cloud in W-NW Scotland, gusty locally. Highest Scottish tops may emerge above the cloud. Drizzle on western slopes easing, cloud thinning and breaking for central and southwest Scotland, sunnier and warmer overall in east. Very warm to hot sunshine for England & Wales.

Warm and sunny. Light-moderate breeze.

## Detailed Forecast for Wednesday, 8 July, 2026

<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b>	West to southwesterly 15mph to occasional 20mph, in places 25mph around higher Pennines for an hour or so from dawn.
<b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	Fairly small, some noticeable gustier spots early in day.
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>No rain expected</b>
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Soon clearing</b> Some patchy cloud around western slopes in the morning, but thinning and dispersing during morning to leave hills clear.
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>70% early morning, becoming practically certain.</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Patchwork of cloud and sun, increasingly sunny; high UV, beware sunburn. Visibility very good.
<b>How Cold? (at 700m)</b>	13C rising to 17 to 19C afternoon, warmest southern tops.
<b>And in the valleys</b>	14C at dawn, rising to 24 to 26C afternoon, warmest east and southern Yorks Dales.

<b>How windy? (On the summits)</b> <b>Effect of wind on you?</b>	West to southwesterly 5 to 15mph, strongest early in day and over North Pennines. <b>Small.</b>	East to southeasterly or variable 10-15mph or less. <b>Small.</b>
<b>How wet?</b> (Precipitation and its impact)	<b>No rain expected</b>	<b>Most likely dry</b> Late in the day, small chance of a very isolated burst of rain.
<b>Cloud on the hills?</b>	<b>Hills clear</b>  Patchy mist some valleys mainly in west at dawn, briefly may drift onto lower hill slopes early in day, but soon all dispersing.	<b>Hills clear</b>
<b>Chance of cloud free summits?</b>	<b>Above 90%</b>	<b>Practically certain</b>
<b>Sunshine?</b> Air clarity (below cloud)	Generally sunny, a little fair-weather cloud. Some early patchy mist, otherwise visibility excellent.	Strong sunshine, some thin high cloud. Visibility good, but some haze.
<b>How Cold? (at 700m)</b>  <b>And in the valleys</b>	14C rising to 20C afternoon.  14C at dawn, rising to 25C afternoon.	16C at dawn rising to 22C; very warm and rather humid especially in west.  14C at dawn, rising to 28C afternoon.

**Planning Outlook****All mountain areas of Britain from Thursday, 9 July, 2026**

Increasingly warm for Scotland, hot for England and Wales this week. Southwesterly winds easing for much of Scotland but remnants of fronts bring further low cloud and drizzle to the west late this week. Locally a chance of thundery downpours in eastern Highlands later Friday, some of which may linger into Saturday but likely fading. A generally fine summertime outlook through the weekend and well into next week as high pressure expands northwards to broadly reside across Britain. Warm but generally pleasant summer temperatures next week. Sunshine and fair-weather cloud, many hills often clear. Easterly breezes for England and Wales.
