

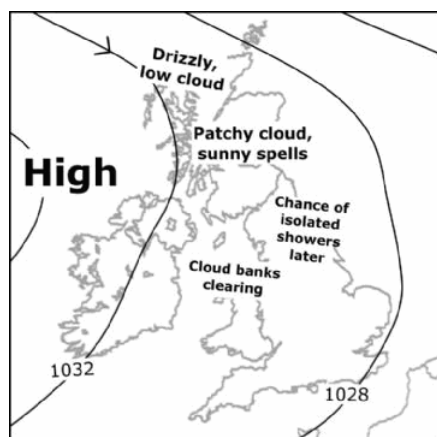
Yorkshire Dales & North Pennines

The entire Yorkshire Dales National Park and North Pennines AONB, including the Three Peaks and Cross Fell, plus Howgills, also south to Forest of Bowland.



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General Summary for Tuesday, 21 July, 2026



British Mountain Summary:

Based on forecast chart for noon 21 July, 2026

Breezy over northern Scottish mountains, tending to strengthen; fairly light wind elsewhere. Most places dry with some patchy cloud on tops largely clearing. Feeling warm in the sun. Northwest Highland coasts hold low cloud and some drizzle much of day. Chance of a late shower over the Pennines.

Headline for Yorkshire Dales & North Pennines

Sun & broken cloud, an odd shower later. Light-moderate breeze.

Detailed Forecast for Tuesday, 21 July, 2026

How windy? (On the summits)	West to northwesterly 10 to 20mph, occasional gusts 25mph higher North Pennines mainly later, some stronger gusts evening into night.
Effect of wind on you?	Mostly small during daytime, some breezier spots higher northern tops.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	Local showers possible late in day Most or all day dry. Chance of an isolated shower by late afternoon into evening, mostly light.
Cloud on the hills?	Little if any Patches of cloud briefly grazing some upper slopes in the morning, soon largely above the tops.
Chance of cloud free summits?	80% rising above 90%
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Patchwork of cloud and sun. Visibility very good.
How Cold? (at 700m)	13C rising to 16C afternoon.
And in the valleys	10C at dawn, rising to 22C afternoon.

How windy? (On the summits)	North to northwesterly 10 to 20mph.	West to northwesterly 10 to 15mph, may increase a little toward evening in north to 15-20mph.
Effect of wind on you?	Mostly small.	Mostly small.
How wet? (Precipitation and its impact)	Possibly a shower later Brief spots of light rain may occur mainly toward north in the morning. Chance of localised mostly light showers later afternoon into evening.	Largely dry Most or all day likely dry. Chance of an isolated shower mainly later in the day.
Cloud on the hills?	Local patches soon clear Some cloud banks in the morning grazing higher terrain, mainly north Pennines above 700-800m. Lifting above the hills during the morning.	Soon above most hills Patches of cloud from dawn, soon mostly above 700m, rising to clear the tops during the morning.
Chance of cloud free summits?	70% rising above 90%	70% rising above 90%
Sunshine? Air clarity (below cloud)	Patchwork of cloud and sun. Visibility very good.	Patchwork of cloud and sun, clouding over for periods. Visibility very good.
How Cold? (at 700m)	11C rising to 15C.	12C rising to 16C afternoon.
And in the valleys	10C at dawn, rising to 22C afternoon.	11C at dawn rising to 22C afternoon.

Planning Outlook

All mountain areas of Britain from Wednesday, 22 July, 2026

Largely dry weather continues this week as high pressure stays nearby. Very dry ground and high fire risk, beware of some ongoing fire management with locally restricted access to hills. A prevailing northwesterly wind brings further low cloud and some drizzle onto northwestern Scottish mountains - more widely across the western Highlands later in the week as the flow turns more westerly, with occasional steadier light rain. Patchy cloud over tops elsewhere, best sunshine and warmth in east and south-facing areas. Westerly winds strengthen everywhere into the weekend, bringing some rain and showers to all regions. A changeable and cooler outlook is expected into the last week of July.
